It's been a long wait, but we are now well on our way to setting up a Credit Union across South Lakeland. We have funding in place for the first five years of operation and already got premises organised in Kendal. Our application to become a credit union is currently being considered by the Prudential Regulation Authority, the people who regulate banks and other financial institutions, and we expect to get the go-ahead from them in under six months.

In the meantime there is lots to do to ensure that everyone in our area knows about us and what we can offer. We've also got to set up our computerised banking system, organise arrangements in each area to take deposits and make loans.

Key to the success of the new credit union is strong support from local people and volunteers willing to help run our business.

We're organising an open session at **Kendal Town Hall at 7.00pm on 21**st **October** so that people can hear what's planned and how they can help get the credit union off the ground. We'd very much welcome your attendance.
