There is a signing up sheet on the notice board for anyone interested in taking part to put their names.



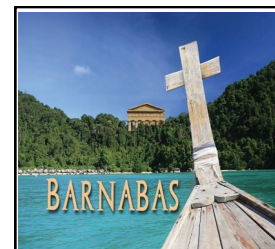
