CHRISTIAN AID GAZA APPEAL ONE YEAR ON FROM 7th OCTOBER

A message from Christian Aid

In a year of conflict tens of thousands of people have been killed, and more than 1.9 million have been displaced following the escalation of violence in Israel and the occupied Palestinian territory on 7 October 2023. As of August 2024, over 40,000 Palestinian people have been killed in Gaza, of whom 14,500 were children. Moreover, around 90,000 Palestinian people have been injured. In Israel, 1,200 people have been killed, and more than 200 civilians have been forcibly taken. With homes and infrastructure destroyed, nearly 2 million people have been displaced, forced to face extreme hunger and disease in overcrowded shelters. Our neighbours in Gaza urgently need shelter, food, clean water, sanitation and medicine. With supplies of essentials running perilously low, and violence threatening to grow, we urgently need more donations to maintain our support.

£2.2m raised through the Middle East Crisis Appeal has enabled Christian Aid to provide support where it's needed most, under intense pressure and in dangerous conditions, but the need remains, and so we have another opportunity one year on to continue to support this invaluable work.
