HEAT PUMP INSTALLATION

It is now some months ago that Church Council approved a proposal to replace the Gas Boiler by a pair of Heat Pumps to support the further reduction of the church's carbon footprint and address the long term sustainability of our building.

The anticipated cost of this project has been estimated at £21,500. A large sum for our church but the good news is that the bulk of this money has been raised and that any support that may be required from the church's general funds will be small.

There will be a substantial reduction in our energy usage because of the efficiency of the Heat

Pumps which of course is great news. However, unfortunately in the immediate term this increase
in efficiency is not anticipated to lead to a saving in our heating costs because electricity costs are
much higher than gas costs. In the longer term the relative price of renewable electricity should lead
to potentially a lower cost relative to gas.

The installation and commissioning of the Heat Pumps is estimated to take about 2 weeks. It is not expected to cause much disruption in the building as it is likely that no heating will be required at that time and alternative arrangements exist to provide hot water when needed.
